INTRODUCTION

The New Zealand Society of Hong Kong has been active since 1957 and aims to promote contacts between New Zealanders living in Hong Kong and those people interested in New Zealand.

SOCIETY OBJECTIVES

- To further encourage the interests of New Zealand and to promote and encourage fellowship among New Zealanders who reside in Hong Kong and in particular, among members of the Society.
- To hold social and cultural activities to promote the observance of national occasions either alone or jointly with other societies, clubs or persons, for the benefit of members of the Society. These activities include ANZAC Day Services, New Zealand Rugby Sevens Events, New Zealand Society Balls, sporting functions, Children's Christmas Party and other special events.
- To carry out fund raising activities and to donate the proceeds to charitable organizations and to the benefit of the Society as proposed by the committee.

BENEFITS

The Society has an active committee of willing volunteers who aim to organise Society functions and oversee the administration of the Society. The Society publishes a regular e-Newsletter, *e-Newz*, containing information about the Society's activities and about products and services of interest to New Zealanders. It also includes special offers for Members.
